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Day 2	<p>The sixth Stakeholder Group meeting began with a welcome from the Chair, Trisha McAuley. The agenda moved towards more detailed scrutiny of the topics to form NG's business plan. The first topic for discussion was Innovation. The Stakeholder Group held a closed session to discuss its approach to questioning National Grid on this issue and then invited National Grid representatives to deliver their presentation. The Stakeholder Group heard a presentation on the vision and strategic direction/objectives on innovation and had an opportunity to raise questions. The Stakeholder Group returned to private session and discussed and agreed the key strategic challenges it wished to pose to NG.</p> <p>The Stakeholder Group were then presented the Business/Investment Planning process, building their knowledge following the previous webinar on this topic. The Group discussed and agreed the key challenges it wished to pose to NG.</p> <p>National Grid Electricity Transmission also presented the T1 performance and the Group had the opportunity to raise questions. The following formal challenges were raised by the Stakeholder Group:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Clearly articulate the lesson learnt from RIIO T1 and how this is shaping the RIIO T2 business plan?2. Demonstrate the efficiencies generated in RIIO-1 and how that forms a baseline for stretch in RIIO-2 to show evolution of spend.3. NGET to explain the difference between the previous NOMs methodology and the new NARMs methodology highlighting any implications or providing examples of differences to the T2 plan? <p>As part of the final closed session, the Chair session, Trisha provided an update on the recent Ofgem Company Chairs' meeting and other meetings with National Grid representatives.</p>
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
